

Boulder firm builds sturdy high-tech reel

William Hollander Co., 5012 Valhalla Dr., Boulder, 80301, 530-1431, has introduced a new single-action fly reel, one of the best-designed in the world, for line Nos. 4 to 9 and salt or fresh water flyfishing.

Designed to handle powerful trout on big waters like the Madison or Bighorn, its sensitive drag and light weight also would make it at home on the Letort or Henry's Fork. The reel sells for \$400. It is 3.45 inches in diameter and the spool width is .920 of an inch. The reel weighs five ounces.

The reel is available in one size only, called the Cutthroat after Colorado's native trout. Hollander, a maker of scientific instruments, plans to introduce other sizes.

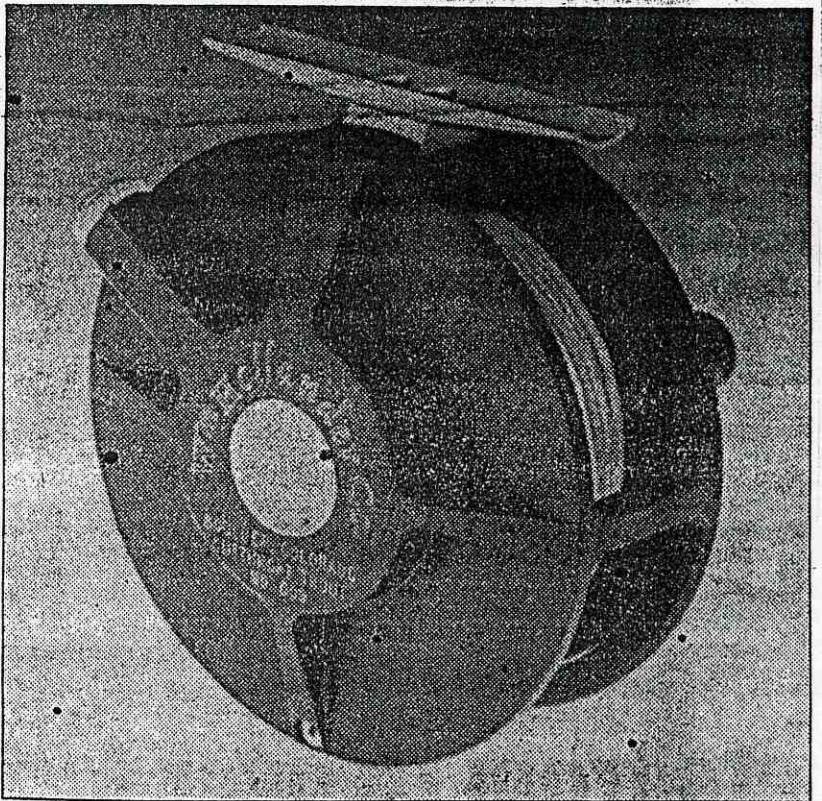
The reel is fully guaranteed for the life of the original owner. Components are aerospace quality stock, and the reel frame and spool are machined from solid aluminum, which is then satin finished and hard black anodized.

The reel is designed for both salt and fresh water use. The reel foot is made of titanium alloy for strength and lightness. Brake drum, screws and springs are stainless steel, and the brake arm, shafts and bushing are beryllium-copper alloy.

A button in the center of the drag adjustment knob activates a unique spool brake. Spool cut-outs are designed to balance the spool handle without addition of a counterweight.
